Program Philosophy: Center for Restorative Programs brings young offenders, victims, and the community together to search for reconciliation and to “make things right.” We also serve 1) Schools: training and intervention for conflict resolution, mediation, restorative discipline, and bullying prevention; and 2) Families: parent-teen mediation, Wraparound facilitation.

Core Training:

The Center for Restorative Programs will offer a mediation training on February 28 & March 1, 2014. The Core Training, which covers the basic tenets of mediation and related communication skills, is open to anyone age 16 or older. Bilingual mediators are especially needed. Space is limited and registrations are taken on a first-come, first-served basis. **Trainees must attend both days.**
